Sustrans Big Pedal/ Parking

25th March-5th April 2019

Get set... we're taking part in Sustrans Big Pedal 2019, the UK's largest inter-school cycling, walking and scooting challenge. The challenge runs from 25 March to 5 April. It's free and we would love everyone to be involved.

The details

On each day of the challenge schools compete to see who can record the greatest number of pupils, staff and parents cycling, walking or scooting to school. You can let us know if you or whoever does the school run has cycled, walked or used a scooter by recording this at the gate in the morning.

It's a great way to get more of our pupils travelling actively to school and is a simple way to boost their physical and mental health.

What's next?

All you need to do is encourage your child(ren) to cycle, walk or scoot to school on as many days as possible during the event, and join them on their way. Don't forget this includes parking at Scarlet's Well and walking from there to school.
